IPSI has been fostering knowledge management by collecting case studies on sustainable use of production landscapes and seascapes from its members, which served as the basis for this study. A review of these case studies was conducted to identify good management practices of Socio-Ecological Production Landscapes and Seascapes, and their contributions to the achievement of the 2020 Aichi Biodiversity Targets.
