Participatory Forest Management Project in Belete-Gera, Ethiopia (2006 – 2010) (エチオピア ベレテ・ゲラ参加型森林管理プロジェクト)

➤ Project description (プロジェクト内容)

- Forest management by “WABUB”
- Capacity building through “Farmers Field School”
- Coffee-based income generation



➤ Project outcome (プロジェクト成果)

- Capacity building of local communities
- Income generation for local people
(“Rainfall alliance” certified-coffee enjoyed 15~25% premium price)
- Model for CSR partnership with Japanese private enterprise



Forest Management and Community Support Project

in Lao P.D.R (2004 – 2009)

(ラオス 森林管理・住民支援プロジェクト)

➤ Project description (プロジェクト内容)

- **Shifting cultivation stabilization** through Community Support Programme Tool (CSPT)
- **Capacity building** for extension staffs and participating farmers



➤ Project outcome (プロジェクト成果)

- **Income generation** for local people
- **Capacity building** of extension staffs and farmers
- **Decreased shifting cultivation area**



◆ Post-Project (新たなプロジェクトの開始)

- ◆ **REDD-related project** utilizing CSPT as a means of giving positive incentive to local communities
